Sri Shanmukhananda Fine Arts, Mumbai (2013): Competed in the Carnatic Vocal competition at Sri Shanmukhananda Fine Arts, which is a prestigious platform for Indian classical music competitions.


Project Samskriti's Anumarga US Tour 2025:

Anumarga is Project Samskriti's first tour to the USA to perform and teach Indian classical art forms. Santhoshini was part of its first tour in the USA, performing and teaching Indian classical music in cities across Texas, California, Tennessee, and New York.

Thyagaraja Aradhana (Thiruvaiyaru, 2013): Santhoshini performed in the annual festival dedicated to the revered Carnatic composer Thyagaraja.

Muthuswami Dikshitar Aradhana (Thiruvaiyaru, 2014): Santhoshini performed in the festival honoring the life and compositions of Muthuswami Dikshitar, one of the Trinity of Carnatic music.

Performed at Festivals in Coimbatore (2014-2016): Took part in festivals that celebrated prominent Carnatic composers and traditional music.



Dance and Cultural Programs: Santhoshini was part of the music ensemble for several dance productions organized by Sadhguru Gurukulam Samskriti, including, "Kanavendamo", "Shivakami", and "Valli Kalyanam". These productions integrate music and dance to portray classical Indian narratives and mythology.
